- ensuring all employees and contractors understand their responsibilities in delivering safe, healthy, and environmentally responsible outcomes for our people, residents, and visitors
- ensuring contractors, working on our behalf are competent to do so and have systems to comply with all relevant legislation, standards, procedures, and other obligations
- ensure that training and awareness focuses on physical and emotional wellbeing
- provide health and wellbeing support throughout the year to help employees manage their own personal wellbeing.
- provide direction, training, supervision and, where appropriate, specialist support to employees, and contractors to enable them to discharge their duty to work responsibly and with due consideration for safety, health, and environment

- review all incidents and communicate lessons learned
